Amendment to H.R. 1719
Offered by Mr. Bishop of Utah

Page 1, after line 5, insert the following:

“SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.

In this Act:

- (1) HISTORIC SITE- The term `Historic Site' means the John Muir National Historic Site in Martinez, California, established by Public Law 88-547 (78 Stat. 753).
- (2) MAP- The term `map' means the map entitled `John Muir National Historic Site Proposed Boundary Expansion', numbered 426/127150, and dated November 2014.
- (3) SECRETARY- The term `Secretary' means the Secretary of the Interior.”.

Page 2, line 1, strike “**Sec. 2.**” And insert “**Sec. 3.**”

Page 2, line 3, strike “of the Interior”.

Page 2, line 4, strike the comma.

Page 2, strike lines 5 through 8 and insert “and any interests in the land that is identified on the map.”.

Page 2, line 9, strike “Upon” and insert “On”.

Page 2, strike line 10 and insert “authorized under subsection (a), the Secretary”.

Page 2, line 11, strike “John Muir”.

Page 2, strike lines 12 and 13 and insert “to include the acquired land.”.

Page 2, line 14, insert “any” before “interests”.

Page 2, strike lines 16 through 18 and insert “as part of the National Historic Site.”.

Amend the long title to read: To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to acquire approximately 44 acres of land in Martinez, California, for inclusion in the John Muir National Historic Site, and for other purposes
