COMMITTEE MARKUP ACTION

The Committee on Natural Resources met in open session on Tuesday, September 12, 2017, and reconvened on Wednesday, September 13, 2017, to consider the following bill:

H.R. 3668 (Rep. Jeff Duncan of SC), To provide for the preservation of sportsmen's heritage and enhance recreation opportunities on Federal land, and for other purposes. "Sportsmen's Heritage and Recreational Enhancement Act" or "SHARE Act"

The Subcommittee on Federal Lands and the Subcommittee on Water, Power and Oceans were discharged from further consideration of H.R. 3668 by unanimous consent.

An Amendment offered by Mr. Huffman (108), fell on a point of order.

An Amendment offered by Mr. Gomez (002), was not agreed to by a roll call vote of 13 yeas and 23 nays.

An Amendment offered by Mr. Beyer (006), was not agreed to by a roll call vote of 13 yeas and 22 nays.

An Amendment offered by Mr. Grijalva (061), was not agreed to by a roll call vote of 12 yeas and 22 nays.

An Amendment offered by Ms. Tsongas (001), was not agreed to by a roll call vote of 13 yeas and 21 nays.

An Amendment offered by Mr. Westerman (Young_093), was agreed to by a roll call vote of 21 yeas and 14 nays.

An Amendment offered by Mr. LaMalfa (026), was agreed to by voice vote.

An Amendment offered by Mr. Johnson of Louisiana (024), was agreed to by voice vote.

H.R. 3668, as amended, was adopted and favorably reported to the House of Representatives by a roll call vote of 22 yeas and 13 nays.
