

## COMMITTEE MARKUP ACTION

The Committee on Natural Resources met in open session on Wednesday, February 14, 2018, to consider the following bills:

**H.R. 835 (Rep. Doug Lamborn)**, To update the map of, and modify the maximum acreage available for inclusion in, the Florissant Fossil Beds National Monument.

The Subcommittee on Federal Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 835 by unanimous consent.

H.R. 835 was adopted and favorably reported to the House of Representatives by unanimous consent.

**H.R. 4134 (Rep. Michael K. Simpson)**, To redesignate the White Clouds Wilderness in the Sawtooth and Challis National Forests in the State of Idaho as the Cecil D. Andrus-White Clouds Wilderness in honor of former Idaho Governor and Secretary of the Interior Cecil D. Andrus. *“Cecil D. Andrus-White Clouds Wilderness Redesignation Act.”*

The Subcommittee on Federal Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 4134 by unanimous consent.

H.R. 4134 was adopted and favorably reported to the House of Representatives by unanimous consent.

**H.R. 4895 (Rep. Bennie G. Thompson)**, To establish the Medgar Evers National Monument in the State of Mississippi, and for other purposes. *“Medgar Evers National Monument Act.”*

The Subcommittee on Federal Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 4895 by unanimous consent.

An amendment offered by Mr. Bishop of Utah [#1], was agreed to by unanimous consent.

H.R. 4895, as amended, was adopted and favorably reported to the House of Representatives by unanimous consent.
