COMMITTEE MARKUP ACTION

The Committee on Natural Resources met in open session on Wednesday, March 7, 2018, to consider the following bills:

H.R. 520 (Rep. Mark E. Amodei), To require the Secretary of the Interior and the Secretary of Agriculture to more efficiently develop domestic sources of the minerals and mineral materials of strategic and critical importance to the economic and national security and manufacturing competitiveness of the United States, and for other purposes. "National Strategic and Critical Minerals Production Act."

The Subcommittee on Energy and Mineral Resources was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 520 by unanimous consent.

An amendment offered by Mr. Gosar [#1], was agreed to by voice vote.

An amendment offered by Mr. Graves of Louisiana [#1], was agreed to by voice vote.

An amendment offered by Mr. Lowenthal [043], was not agreed to by a roll call vote of 16 yeas and 20 nays.

An amendment in the nature of a substitute offered by Mr. Grijalva [002], was not agreed to by a roll call vote of 17 yeas and 20 nays.

H.R. 520, as amended, was adopted and ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by a roll call vote of 21 yeas and 16 nays.

H.R. 4731 (**Rep. Stacey E. Plaskett**), To extend the retained use estate for the Caneel Bay resort in St. John, United States Virgin Islands, and for other purposes.

The Subcommittee on Federal Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 4731 by unanimous consent.

An amendment offered by Mr. Bishop of Utah [#1], was agreed to by voice vote.

An amendment offered by Mr. Grijalva [080], was not agreed to by voice vote.

H.R. 4731, as amended, was adopted and ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by voice vote.

H.R. 5133 (Rep. Rob Bishop of UT), To reauthorize the Federal Land Transaction Facilitation Act, and for other purposes. "Federal Land Transaction Facilitation Act Reauthorization of 2018."

An amendment offered by Mr. Bishop of Utah [#1], was agreed to by unanimous consent.

H.R. 5133, as amended, was adopted and ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by unanimous consent.
