

COMMITTEE MARKUP ACTION

The Committee on Natural Resources met in open session on Wednesday, May 16, 2018, to consider the following bills:

H.R. 224 (Rep. Don Young), To amend the Marine Mammal Protection Act of 1972 to allow importation of polar bear trophies taken in sport hunts in Canada before the date the polar bear was determined to be a threatened species under the Endangered Species Act of 1973, and for other purposes. *“Polar Bear Conservation and Fairness Act”*.

The Subcommittee on Federal Lands and the Subcommittee on Water, Power and Oceans were discharged from further consideration of H.R. 224 by unanimous consent.

H.R. 224 was adopted and ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by voice vote.

H.R. 857 (Rep. Paul Cook), To provide for conservation and enhanced recreation activities in the California Desert Conservation Area, and for other purposes. *“California Off-Road Recreation and Conservation Act”*.

The Subcommittee on Federal Lands and the Subcommittee on Indian, Insular and Alaska Native Affairs were discharged from further consideration of H.R. 857 by unanimous consent.

An amendment offered by Mr. Cook [#1], was agreed to by unanimous consent.

H.R. 857, as amended, was adopted and ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by unanimous consent.

H.R. 3045 (Rep. Luke Messer), To amend the National Trails System Act to extend the Lewis and Clark National Historic Trail, and for other purposes. *“Eastern Legacy Extension Act”*.

The Subcommittee on Federal Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 3045 by unanimous consent.

An amendment offered by Mr. Bishop of Utah [#1], was agreed to by unanimous consent.

H.R. 3045, as amended, was adopted and ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by unanimous consent.

H.R. 3186 (Rep. Niki Tsongas), To establish an Every Kid Outdoors program, and for other purposes. *“Every Kid Outdoors Act”*.

The Subcommittee on Federal Lands and the Subcommittee on Water, Power and Oceans were discharged from further consideration of H.R. 3186 by unanimous consent.

An amendment offered by Ms. Bordallo [050] was agreed to by unanimous consent.

An amendment offered by Mr. Bishop of UT [#1], was agreed to by unanimous consent.

H.R. 3186 as amended, was adopted and favorably reported to the House of Representatives by unanimous consent.

H.R. 3916 (Rep. Ken Calvert), To amend the Endangered Species Act of 1973 to vest in the Secretary of the Interior functions under that Act with respect to species of fish that spawn in fresh or estuarine waters and migrate to ocean waters, and species of fish that spawn in ocean waters and migrate to fresh waters. *“Federally Integrated Species Health Act” or “FISH Act”*.

The Subcommittee on Water, Power and Oceans was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 3916 by unanimous consent.

An amendment offered by Mr. Lamborn [#1], was agreed to by voice vote.

H.R. 3916, as amended, was adopted and ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by a roll call vote of 22 yeas and 14 nays.

H.R. 4419 (Rep. Dan Newhouse), To facilitate and streamline the Bureau of Reclamation and Bureau of Indian Affairs processes for creating or expanding certain water projects, and for other purposes. *“Bureau of Reclamation and Bureau of Indian Affairs Water Project Streamlining Act”*.

The Subcommittee on Water, Power and Oceans was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 4419 by unanimous consent.

An amendment offered by Mr. LaMalfa [#1], was agreed to by voice vote.

An amendment offered by Mr. Huffman [140], was not agreed to by a roll call vote of 14 yeas and 21 nays.

H.R. 4419, as amended, was adopted and ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by a roll call vote of 21 yeas and 14 nays.
