At the end of the bill, add the following:

3	Section 204(c)(1) of the Federal Land Policy and
4	Management Act of 1976 (43 U.S.C. 1714(c)(1)) is
5	amended to read as follows:
6	"(c)(1) After the date of the enactment of the Yellow-
7	stone Gateway Protection Act, a withdrawal aggregating
8	85,000 acres or more may be made or extended pursuant
9	to this paragraph. The Secretary shall notify both Houses
10	of Congress of such a withdrawal not later than the effec-
11	tive date of such withdrawal. Such withdrawal shall termi-
12	nate and become ineffective at the end of the 90-day pe-
13	riod (not counting days on which the Senate or the House
14	of Representatives has adjourned for more than 3 consecu-
15	tive days) beginning on the day notice of such withdrawal
16	has been submitted to the Senate and the House of Rep-
17	resentatives if the Congress has not adopted a concurrent
18	resolution stating that such House approves of the with-
19	drawal.".
