## **Committee on Natural Resources – Markup Action**

The Committee on Natural Resources met on Wednesday, July 17, 2019, and considered the following bills:

## H.R. 1373, "Grand Canyon Centennial Protection Act."

Subcommittee on National Parks, Forests, and Public Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 1373 by unanimous consent.

- An amendment offered by Mr. Gosar #1 to the Grijalva amendment in the nature of a substitute was not agreed to by a roll call vote of 14 yeas and 20 nays.

## **H.R. 2181,** "Chaco Cultural Heritage Area Protection Act of 2019."

## H.R. 3405, "Removing Uranium from the Critical Minerals List Act."
