

Committee on Natural Resources – Markup Action

The Committee on Natural Resources met on Wednesday, September 18, 2019, and considered the following bills:

H.R. 182 (Rep. Keating), To extend the authorization for the Cape Cod National Seashore Advisory Commission.

Subcommittee on National Parks, Forests, and Public Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 182 by unanimous consent.

- H.R. 182 was adopted and ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by unanimous consent.

H.R. 263 (Rep. Suozzi), To rename the Oyster Bay National Wildlife Refuge as the Congressman Lester Wolff Oyster Bay National Wildlife Refuge.

Subcommittee on Water, Oceans, and Wildlife was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 263 by unanimous consent.

- H.R. 263 was adopted and ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by unanimous consent.

H.R. 473 (Rep. Neguse), To authorize the Every Word We Utter Monument to establish a commemorative work in the District of Columbia and its environs, and for other purposes.

Subcommittee on National Parks, Forests, and Public Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 473 by unanimous consent.

- An amendment offered by Mr. Grijalva #1 was agreed to by voice vote.
- H.R. 473, as amended, was adopted and ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by voice vote.

H.R. 560 (Rep. Sablan), “*Northern Mariana Islands Residents Relief Act.*”

- An amendment in the nature of a substitute offered by Mr. Sablan was agreed to by voice vote.
- H.R. 560, as amended, was adopted and ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by voice vote.

H.R. 737 (Rep. Sablan), “*Shark Fin Sales Elimination Act of 2019.*”

Subcommittee on Water, Oceans, and Wildlife was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 737.

- An amendment in the nature of a substitute offered by Mr. Webster was offered and withdrawn.
- H.R. 737 was adopted and ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives a roll call vote of 16 yeas and 13 nays.

H.R. 1023 (Rep. Quigley), “*Great Lakes Fishery Research Authorization Act of 2019.*”

Subcommittee on Water, Oceans, and Wildlife was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 1023 by unanimous consent.

- An amendment offered by Mr. McClintock #1 was not agreed to by a roll call vote of 15 yeas and 20 nays.
- H.R. 1023 was adopted and ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by a roll call vote of 20 yeas and 15 nays.

H.R. 1218 (Rep. Young), “*American Fisheries Advisory Committee Act.*”

Subcommittee on Water, Oceans, and Wildlife was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 1218 by unanimous consent.

- The sponsor name of the Grijalva amendment in the nature of a substitute was changed to Mr. Cunningham/Mr. Graves by unanimous consent.
- The Cunningham/Graves amendment in the nature of a substitute was agreed to by unanimous consent.
- H.R. 1218, as amended, was adopted and ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by unanimous consent.

H.R. 1314 (Rep. Young), “*Integrated Coastal and Ocean Observation System Act Amendments of 2019.*”

Subcommittee on Water, Oceans, and Wildlife was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 1314 by unanimous consent.

- An amendment offered by Mr. Grijalva #1 was agreed to by unanimous consent.
- H.R. 1314, as amended, was adopted and ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by unanimous consent.

H.R. 1380 (Rep. Quigley), “*Big Cat Public Safety Act.*”

Subcommittee on Water, Oceans, and Wildlife was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 1380 by unanimous consent.

- An amendment offered by Mr. Bishop #2 was not agreed to by a roll call vote of 16 yeas and 19 nays.
- H.R. 1380 was adopted and ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by a roll call vote of 21 yeas and 14 nays.

H.R. 1446 (Rep. Clay), “*Multinational Species Conservation Funds Semipostal Stamp Reauthorization Act of 2019.*”

Subcommittee on Water, Oceans, and Wildlife was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 1446 by unanimous consent.

- An amendment offered by Mr. Grijalva #1 was agreed to by unanimous consent.

- H.R. 1446, as amended, was adopted and ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by unanimous consent.

H.R. 2189 (Rep. Ruppertsberger), “*Digital Coast Act.*”

Subcommittee on Water, Oceans, and Wildlife was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 2189 by unanimous consent.

- An amendment offered by Mr. Grijalva #1 was agreed to by unanimous consent.
- H.R. 2189, as amended, was adopted and ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by unanimous consent.

H.R. 2245 (Rep. Grijalva), “*CECIL Act*” or “*Conserving Ecosystems by Ceasing the Importation of Large Animal Trophies Act.*”

Subcommittee on Water, Oceans, and Wildlife was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 2245 by unanimous consent.

- An amendment offered by Mr. McClintock #1 to the Grijalva amendment in the nature of a substitute was not agreed to by a roll call vote of 17 yeas and 18 nays.
- An amendment offered by Mr. Lamborn #2 to the Grijalva amendment in the nature of a substitute was not agreed to by a roll call vote of 16 yeas and 19 nays.
- An amendment offered by Mr. Lamborn #3 to the Grijalva amendment in the nature of a substitute was not agreed to by a roll call vote of 16 yeas and 19 nays.
- The Grijalva amendment in the nature of a substitute was agreed to by voice vote.
- H.R. 2245, as amended, was adopted and ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by a roll call vote of 19 yeas and 16 nays.

H.R. 2405 (Rep. Huffman), “*National Sea Grant College Program Amendments Act of 2019.*”

Subcommittee on Water, Oceans, and Wildlife was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 2405 by unanimous consent.

- An amendment offered by Mr. Grijalva #1 was agreed to by voice vote.
- H.R. 2405, as amended, was adopted and ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by a roll call vote of 23 yeas and 12 nays.

H.R. 2406 (Rep. Case), “*National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration Commissioned Officer Corps Amendments Act of 2019.*”

Subcommittee on Water, Oceans, and Wildlife was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 2406 by unanimous consent.

- An amendment in the nature of a substitute offered by Mr. Grijalva was agreed to by voice vote.
- H.R. 2406, as amended, was adopted and ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by a roll call vote of 21 yeas and 14 nays.

H.R. 2490 (Rep. Fortenberry), To amend the National Trails System Act to direct the Secretary of the Interior to conduct a study on the feasibility of designating the Chief Standing Bear National Historic Trail, and for other purposes.

Subcommittee on National Parks, Forests, and Public Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 2490 by unanimous consent.

- An amendment offered by Mr. Grijalva #1 was agreed to by unanimous consent.
- H.R. 2490, as amended, was adopted and ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by unanimous consent.

H.R. 2819 (Rep. Kim), “*Gold Star Families National Monument Extension Act*”.

Subcommittee on National Parks, Forests, and Public Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 2819 by unanimous consent.

- An amendment offered by Mr. Grijalva #1 was agreed to by unanimous consent.
- H.R. 2819, as amended, was adopted and ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by unanimous consent.
