

**AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE  
TO H.R. 5068  
OFFERED BY MR. GRIJALVA OF ARIZONA**

Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the following:

**1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2       This Act may be cited as the “Women Who Worked  
3 on the Home Front World War II Memorial Act”.

**4 SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION TO ESTABLISH COMMEMORATIVE  
5 WORK.**

6       (a) IN GENERAL.—The Women Who Worked on the  
7 Home Front Foundation may establish a commemorative  
8 work on Federal land in the District of Columbia and its  
9 environs to commemorate the commitment and service  
10 represented by women who worked on the home front dur-  
11 ing World War II.

12       (b) COMPLIANCE WITH STANDARDS FOR COMMEMO-  
13 RATIVE WORKS.—The establishment of the commemora-  
14 tive work under this section shall be in accordance with  
15 chapter 89 of title 40, United States Code (commonly  
16 known as the “Commemorative Works Act”).

17       (c) PROHIBITION ON THE USE OF FEDERAL  
18 FUNDS.—

1           (1) IN GENERAL.—Federal funds may not be  
2 used to pay any expense of the establishment of the  
3 commemorative work under this section.

4           (2) RESPONSIBILITY OF WOMEN WHO WORKED  
5 ON THE HOME FRONT FOUNDATION.—The Women  
6 Who Worked on the Home Front Foundation shall  
7 be solely responsible for acceptance of contributions  
8 for, and payment of the expenses of, the establish-  
9 ment of the commemorative work under this section.

10 (d) DEPOSIT OF EXCESS FUNDS.—

11           (1) IN GENERAL.—If upon payment of all ex-  
12 penses for the establishment of the memorial (in-  
13 cluding the maintenance and preservation amount  
14 required by section 8906(b)(1) of title 40, United  
15 States Code), there remains a balance of funds re-  
16 ceived for the establishment of the commemorative  
17 work, the Women Who Worked on the Home Front  
18 Foundation shall transmit the amount of the balance  
19 to the Secretary of the Interior for deposit in the ac-  
20 count provided for in section 8906(b)(3) of title 40,  
21 United States Code.

22           (2) ON EXPIRATION OF AUTHORITY.—If upon  
23 expiration of the authority for the commemorative  
24 work under section 8903(e) of title 40, United  
25 States Code, there remains a balance of funds re-

1       ceived for the establishment of the commemorative  
2       work, the Women Who Worked on the Home Front  
3       Foundation shall transmit the amount of the balance  
4       to a separate account with the National Park Foun-  
5       dation for memorials, to be available to the Sec-  
6       retary of the Interior or Administrator (as appro-  
7       priate) following the process provided in section  
8       8906(b)(4) of title 40, United States Code, for ac-  
9       counts established under section 8906(b)(2) or (3)  
10      of title 40, United States Code.
