

Committee on Natural Resources – Markup Action

The Committee on Natural Resources met on Wednesday, March 11, 2020, to consider the following bills. Per Committee Rule 9(f)(1), amendments and roll call votes will be posted no later than 24 hours after the vote is taken. These documents can be found at docs.house.gov, found [here](#).

[H.R. 139](#), To establish the Springfield Race Riot National Historic Monument in the State of Illinois, and for other purposes. “*Springfield Race Riot National Historic Monument Act.*”

Subcommittee on National Parks, Forests, and Public Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 139 by unanimous consent.

- Chair Raúl M. Grijalva (D-AZ) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute. The amendment was agreed to by unanimous consent.
- The bill, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by unanimous consent.

[H.R. 1162](#), To establish a grant program for the funding of water recycling and reuse projects, and for other purposes. “*Water Recycling Investment and Improvement Act.*”

Subcommittee on Water, Oceans, and Wildlife was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 1162 by unanimous consent.

- Representative Grace Napolitano (D-CA) offered an amendment designated Napolitano #1. The amendment was agreed to by voice vote.
- The bill, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by a roll call vote of 19 yeas and 12 nays.

[H.R. 2473](#), To promote water supply reliability and improved water management for rural communities, the State of California, and the Nation, and for other purposes. “*Securing Access for the central Valley and Enhancing (SAVE) Water Resources Act.*”

Subcommittee on Water, Oceans, and Wildlife was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 2473 by unanimous consent.

- Chair Raúl M. Grijalva (D-AZ) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute.
- Representative Tom McClintock (R-CA) offered an amendment designated McClintock #1 to the amendment in the nature of a substitute. The amendment was not agreed to by a roll call vote of 13 yeas and 15 nays.
- The amendment in the nature of a substitute offered by Chair Grijalva was agreed to by a roll call vote of 17 yeas and 14 nays.
- The bill, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by a roll call vote of 19 yeas and 12 nays.

[H.R. 3094](#), To designate the National Pulse Memorial located at 1912 South Orange Avenue, Orlando, Florida, 32806, and for other purposes.

Subcommittee on National Parks, Forests, and Public Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 3094 by unanimous consent.

- Chair Raúl M. Grijalva (D-AZ) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute. The amendment was agreed to by unanimous consent.
- The bill, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by unanimous consent.

[H.R. 3250](#), To require the Secretary of the Interior to conduct a special resource study of the sites associated with the life and legacy of the noted American philanthropist and business executive Julius Rosenwald, with a special focus on the Rosenwald Schools, and for other purposes. “*Julius Rosenwald and the Rosenwald Schools Act of 2019.*”

Subcommittee on National Parks, Forests, and Public Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 3250 by unanimous consent.

- Chair Raúl M. Grijalva (D-AZ) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute. The amendment was agreed to by unanimous consent.
- The bill, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by unanimous consent.

[H.R. 3349](#), To authorize the Daughters of the Republic of Texas to establish the Republic of Texas Legation Memorial as a commemorative work in the District of Columbia, and for other purposes. “*Republic of Texas Legation Memorial Act.*”

Subcommittee on National Parks, Forests, and Public Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 3349 by unanimous consent.

- Chair Raúl M. Grijalva (D-AZ) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute. The amendment was agreed to by unanimous consent.
- The bill, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by unanimous consent.

[H.R. 3723](#), To promote desalination project development and drought resilience, and for other purposes. “*Desalination Development Act.*”

Subcommittee on Water, Oceans, and Wildlife was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 3723 by unanimous consent.

- Representative Mike Levin (D-CA) offered an amendment designated Levin #1. The amendment was agreed to by voice vote.
- The bill, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by a roll call vote of 13 yeas and 10 nays.

[H.R. 4153](#), To amend the Indian Health Care Improvement Act to authorize urban Indian organizations to enter into arrangements for the sharing of medical services and facilities, and for other purposes. “*Health Care Access for Urban Native Veterans Act.*”

Subcommittee for Indigenous Peoples of the United States was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 4153 by unanimous consent.

- The bill was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by unanimous consent.

[H.R. 4891](#), To provide for the conduct of certain water security measures in the Western United States, and for other purposes. “*Western Water Security Act of 2019.*”

Subcommittee on Water, Oceans, and Wildlife was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 4891 by unanimous consent.

- Chair Raúl M. Grijalva (D-AZ) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute. The amendment in the nature of a substitute offered by Chair Grijalva was agreed to by voice vote.
- The bill, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by a roll call vote of 14 yeas and 11 nays.

[H.R. 5068](#), To authorize the Women Who Worked on the Home Front Foundation to establish a commemorative work in the District of Columbia and its environs, and for other purposes. “*Women Who Worked on the Home Front World War II Memorial Act.*”

Subcommittee on National Parks, Forests, and Public Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 5068 by unanimous consent.

- Chair Raúl M. Grijalva (D-AZ) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute. The amendment was agreed to by unanimous consent.
- The bill, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by unanimous consent.

[H.R. 5126](#), To require individuals fishing for Gulf reef fish to use certain descending devices, and for other purposes. “*Direct Enhancement of Snapper Conservation and the Economy through Novel Devices Act of 2019*” or the “*DESCEND Act of 2019*.”

Subcommittee on Water, Oceans, and Wildlife was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 5126 by unanimous consent.

- Chair Raúl M. Grijalva (D-AZ) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute.
- Chair Grijalva offered an amendment designated Grijalva #1 to the amendment in the nature of a substitute. The amendment was agreed to by unanimous consent.
- The amendment in the nature of a substitute, as amended, was agreed to by unanimous consent.
- The bill, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by unanimous consent.
