

Committee on Natural Resources – Markup Action Report

H.R. 1884, To repeal section 3003 of the Carl Levin and Howard P. "Buck" McKeon National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2015, and for other purposes. *Save Oak Flat Act*.

Subcommittee on National Parks, Forests, and Public Lands and the Subcommittee for Indigenous Peoples of the United States were discharged from further consideration of H.R. 1884.

- Rep. Stauber offered an amendment designated Stauber #6. The amendment was not agreed to by a roll call vote of 21 yeas and 23 nays.
- The bill was adopted and ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by a roll call vote of 23 yeas and 20 nays.

H.R. 1492, To prevent methane waste and pollution from oil and gas operations, and for other purposes. *Methane Waste Prevention Act of 2021*.

Subcommittee on Energy and Mineral Resources was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 1492.

The amendment was not agreed to by a roll call vote of 18 yeas and 24 nays.
