On Wednesday, July 14, 2021, at 11:00 a.m. EDT via the Cisco WebEx and livestreamed on the Committee's <u>YouTube</u> page, the Committee on Natural Resources will meet to consider the following bills:

- H.R. 820 (Rep. LaHood), To establish the New Philadelphia National Historical Park in the State of Illinois as a unit of the National Park System, and for other purposes. *New Philadelphia National Historical Park Act.*
- <u>H.R. 972</u> (Rep. Calvert), To provide for the establishment of the Western Riverside County Wildlife Refuge. *Wildlife Refuge Conservation and Recreation for the Community Act.*
- H.R. 1154 (Rep. McEachin), To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to conduct a study to assess the suitability and feasibility of designating certain land as the Great Dismal Swamp National Heritage Area, and for other purposes. *Great Dismal Swamp National Heritage Area Act.*
- <u>H.R. 1664</u> (Rep. Veasey), To authorize the National Medal of Honor Museum Foundation to establish a commemorative work in the District of Columbia and its environs, and for other purposes.
- H.R. 1908 (Rep. Case), To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to conduct a study to assess the suitability and feasibility of designating certain land as the Ka'ena Point National Heritage Area, and for other purposes. *Ka'ena Point National Heritage Area Act*.
- H.R. 2278 (Rep. Connolly), To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to designate the September 11th National Memorial Trail, and for other purposes.
- H.R. 2444 (Rep. González-Colón), To establish Fort San Gerónimo del Boquerón in Puerto Rico as an affiliated area of the National Park System, and for other purposes. *Fort San Gerónimo Preservation Act.*
- H.R. 2497 (Rep. Neguse), To establish the Amache National Historic Site in the State of Colorado as a unit of the National Park System, and for other purposes. *Amache National Historic Site Act.*
- <u>H.R. 2780</u> (Rep. Grijalva), To provide for climate change planning, mitigation, adaptation, and resilience in the United States Territories and Freely Associated States, and for other purposes. *Insular Area Climate Change Act.*

- H.R. 2899 (Rep. San Nicolas), To direct the Secretary of the Interior to conduct a study to assess the suitability and feasibility of designating areas within the island of Guam as a National Heritage Area, and for other purposes.
- H.R. 3113 (Rep. Blake Moore), To require the Secretary of the Interior, the Secretary of Agriculture, and the Assistant Secretary of the Army for Civil Works to digitize and make publicly available geographic information system mapping data relating to public access to Federal land and waters for outdoor recreation, and for other purposes. *MAPLand Act.*
- H.R. 3616 (Rep. Blake Moore), To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to conduct a study to assess the suitability and feasibility of designating certain land as the Bear River National Heritage Area, and for other purposes. *Bear River National Heritage Area Study Act.*
- **H.R. 3764** (Rep. Grijalva), To direct the Administrator of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration to provide for ocean-based climate solutions to reduce carbon emissions and global warming; to make coastal communities more resilient; and to provide for the conservation and restoration of ocean and coastal habitats, biodiversity, and marine mammal and fish populations; and for other purposes. *Ocean-Based Climate Solutions Act of 2021. (Amendments to H.R. 3764 must be drafted to the amendment in the nature of a substitute, attached to this notice. Bill text is also attached)*
- **H.R. 4300** (Rep. Miller-Meeks), To direct the Secretary of the Interior to make free National Parks and Federal Recreational Lands Passes available to members of the Armed Forces, and for other purposes. *Veterans in Parks (VIP) Act. (Bill text attached)*

Note that all amendments filed by this time will be given priority recognition at the markup. Amendments filed after the deadline or during the markup must also be filed electronically at <u>HNRCdocs@mail.house.gov</u>.

The Chair may roll votes on amendments and final passage; however, procedural votes may occur at any time and must be disposed of in real time.
