

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2773

OFFERED BY MRS. DINGELL OF MICHIGAN

Page 16, lines 13-16, strike “, then the” and all that follows through “prevail.” and insert “or the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act, then the provision in the Alaska National Interest Lands Conservation Act or the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act shall prevail.”

Page 19, line 22, strike “upon Indian Tribes’ wildlife management responsibilities.” and insert “upon an Indian Tribe’s wildlife management responsibilities. Any funding allocated to Indian Tribes in Alaska may only be used in a manner consistent with the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act, the Alaska National Interest Lands Conservation Act, and the Alaska Statehood Act. Alaska Native Corporations or Tribes may enter into cooperative agreements with the State of Alaska on conservation projects of mutual concern.”

Page 21, line 19, insert “If any conflict arises between any provision of this Act and any provision of the Alaska National Interest Lands Conservation Act or the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act, then the provision in the Alaska National Interest Lands Conservation Act

or the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act shall prevail.” after the period.
