## AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H. Res. 1252

## OFFERED BY MR. GRIJALVA OF ARIZONA

Strike the resolving clause and all that follows and insert the following:

1	Resolved, That the Secretary of the Interior is di-
2	rected to transmit to the House of Representatives, not
3	later than 14 days after the date of the adoption of this
4	resolution, copies of any document, memorandum, cor-
5	respondence, and other communication or any portion of
6	any such communication, that refers or relates to the min-
7	eral withdrawal within the Superior National Forest and
8	composition of the Duluth Complex, including the fol-
9	lowing:
10	(1) All documents and communications relating
11	to the minerals found within the Duluth complex, in-
12	cluding but not limited to any reference to—
13	(A) the amount of copper or recognized
14	critical minerals found; and
15	(B) minerals needed for infrastructure, re-
16	newable energy, or electric vehicle production.

1	(2) All documents and communications refer-
2	ring or relating to initiating the mineral withdrawal
3	process within Superior National Forest.
4	(3) All documents and communications relating
5	to the impact of the mineral withdrawal on Twin
6	Metals operation, including but not limited to any
7	reference to—
8	(A) preventing production of minerals;
9	(B) union project labor agreements; and
10	(C) the loss of economic benefits at the
11	State and local level.
12	(4) All documents and communications refer-
13	ring or relating to the analysis of Twin Metal's min-
14	ing operation plan.
15	(5) All documents and communications relating
16	to the impact of the two-year pause on mineral ac-
17	tivity in Superior National Forest while the mineral
18	withdrawal application is considered, including but
19	not limited to any reference to—
20	(A) national security implications;
21	(B) mineral supply chain stability implica-
22	tions;
23	(C) increased dependence on foreign min-
24	erals: and

1	(D) the economic losses at the State and
2	local level.
3	(6) Any meeting or communication that oc-
4	curred between Secretary Debra Haaland, or her
5	representative, and environmental advocacy groups
6	referring or relating to the mineral withdrawal appli-
7	cation in Superior National Forest.
