To amend the Coastal Barrier Resources Act to create an exemption for certain shoreline borrow sites.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXEMPTION TO COASTAL BARRIER RESTRIC-**
4 **TIONS FOR SHORELINE BORROW SITES.**

5 Section 6 of the Coastal Barrier Resources Act (16
6 U.S.C. 3505) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
7 lowing new subsection:

8 “(e) BORROW SITE.—Section 5 shall not apply to ex-
9 penditures or financial assistance relating to the use of
10 funds to use a borrow site located within the System if

1 such site has been in use as a borrow site by a coastal
2 storm risk management project for a period of more than
3 15 years.”.
