

COMMITTEE ON NATURAL RESOURCES -- ACTION REPORT

The Committee on Natural Resources met in open session on Tuesday, March 12, 2024, to consider the following measures. [H.R. 6862](#) (Rep. Lamborn), To amend the FAST Act to include certain mineral production activities as a covered project, and for other purposes.

The Subcommittee on Energy and Mineral Resources was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 6862.

- Representative Doug Lamborn (R-CO) offered an Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Lamborn_064.
The amendment in the nature of a substitute was agreed to by **voice vote**.
- Representative Sydney Kamlager-Dove (D-CA) offered an Amendment to the Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Kamlager-Dove #1.
The amendment was not agreed to by a roll call vote of **14 to 20**.

H.R. 6862, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by roll call vote of **22 to 13**.

[H.R. 1657](#) (Rep. Stauber), “*Lake Winnibigoshish Land Exchange Act of 2023*”

The Subcommittee on Federal Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 1657.

H.R. 5443 (Rep. Lee of NV), “*Accelerating Appraisals and Conservation Efforts Act*” or the “*AACE Act*”

The Subcommittee on Federal Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 5443.
