

**AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE
TO H.R. 8012
OFFERED BY MR. WESTERMAN OF ARKANSAS**

Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the following:

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the “Jackie Robinson Ball-
3 park National Commemorative Site Act”.

**4 SEC. 2. JACKIE ROBINSON BALLPARK NATIONAL COM-
5 MEMORATIVE SITE.**

6 (a) DEFINITIONS.—In this Act:

7 (1) SECRETARY.—The term “Secretary” means
8 the Secretary of the Interior.

9 (2) SITE.—The term “Site” means the Jackie
10 Robinson Ballpark National Commemorative Site
11 designated by subsection (b).

12 (3) STATE.—The term “State” means the State
13 of Florida.

14 (b) DESIGNATION.—Jackie Robinson Ballpark in
15 Daytona Beach, Florida, is hereby designated as the Jack-
16 ie Robinson Ballpark National Commemorative Site.

17 (c) AFRICAN AMERICAN CIVIL RIGHTS NETWORK.—
18 The Site shall be part of the African American Civil

1 Rights Network established under the African American
2 Civil Rights Network Act of 2017 (Public Law 115–104).

3 (d) ADMINISTRATION.—

4 (1) COOPERATIVE AGREEMENTS.—The Sec-
5 retary may enter into cooperative agreements with
6 appropriate public or private entities for interpreta-
7 tive and educational purposes related to the Site.

8 (2) EFFECT OF DESIGNATION.—The Site shall
9 not be a unit of the National Park System.

10 (3) LIMITATIONS.—Nothing in this Act—

11 (A) authorizes the Secretary to interfere
12 with the rights of any person with respect to
13 private property or any local zoning ordinance
14 or land use plan of the State or any political
15 subdivision thereof;

16 (B) affects the administration of the Site
17 by any owner of the Site; or

18 (C) authorizes the Secretary to acquire
19 land or interests in land through condemnation
20 or otherwise.

21 (e) SPECIAL RESOURCE STUDY.—

22 (1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary shall conduct
23 a special resource study of the Site to evaluate the
24 national significance of the Site and determine the

1 suitability and feasibility of designating the Site as
2 a unit of the National Park System.

3 (2) ALTERNATIVES.—The Secretary shall con-
4 sider alternatives for preservation, protection, and
5 interpretation of the Site by Federal, State, or local
6 government entities, or private and nonprofit organi-
7 zations.

8 (3) CONDUCT OF STUDY.—The study shall be
9 conducted in accordance with section 100507 of title
10 54, United States Code.

11 (4) REPORT.—Not later than 2 years after the
12 date on which funds are made available to conduct
13 the study, the Secretary shall submit a report to
14 Congress that describes the results of the study and
15 any recommendations of the Secretary with respect
16 to the Site.
