

**AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE
TO H.R. 183
OFFERED BY MR. MCCLINTOCK OF CALIFORNIA**

Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the following:

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the “Law Enforcement Offi-
3 cer and Firefighter Recreation Pass Act”.

**4 SEC. 2. NATIONAL RECREATIONAL PASSES FOR LAW EN-
5 FORCEMENT OFFICERS AND FIREFIGHTERS.**

6 Section 805(b) of the Federal Lands Recreation En-
7 hancement Act (16 U.S.C. 6804(b)) is amended—

8 (1) by amending paragraph (3) to read as fol-
9 lows:

10 “(3) ANNUAL PASSES.—The Secretary shall
11 make the National Parks and Federal Recreational
12 Lands Pass available, at no cost, to—

13 “(A) a member of the Armed Forces and
14 their dependents; or

15 “(B) a law enforcement officer or fire-
16 fighter,

17 who provide adequate proof of eligibility for such
18 pass as determined by the Secretary.”.

1 (2) by adding at the end the following:

2 “(4) DEFINITIONS.—In this subsection:

3 “(A) FIREFIGHTER.—The term ‘fire-
4 fighter’ means any employee of the Federal
5 Government, a State, a unit of local govern-
6 ment, or an Indian Tribe who performs work
7 directly related to suppressing fires, including
8 wildland fires.

9 “(B) LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER.—The
10 term ‘law enforcement officer’ means any offi-
11 cer, agent, or employee of the Federal Govern-
12 ment, a State, a unit of local government, or an
13 Indian Tribe authorized by law or by a govern-
14 ment agency to engage in or supervise the pre-
15 vention, detection, or investigation of any viola-
16 tion of criminal law or who is authorized by law
17 to supervise sentenced criminal offenders.”.

Amend the title so as to read: “A bill to amend the Federal Lands Recreation Enhancement Act to provide for a free annual National Parks and Federal Recreational Lands Pass for law enforcement officers and firefighters.”.
