[H.R. 2556 \(Rep. Hunt\)](#), “*CORE Act of 2025*”

The Subcommittee on Energy and Mineral Resources was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 2556.

- Rep. Wesley Hunt (R-TX) offered an Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Hunt_019 ANS. The Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute was agreed to by **voice vote**.
- Ranking Member Jared Huffman (D-CA) offered an amendment to the Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Huffman #1. The amendment was not agreed to by a **roll call vote of 18 yeas to 23 nays**.
- Rep. Julia Brownley (D-CA) offered an amendment to the Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Brownley #2. The amendment was not agreed to by a **roll call vote of 18 yeas to 23 nays**.
- Rep. Yassamin Ansari (D-AZ) offered an amendment to the Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Ansari #3. The amendment was not agreed to by a **roll call vote of 16 yeas to 26 nays**.
- Rep. Maxine Dexter (D-OR) offered an amendment to the Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Dexter #4. The amendment was not agreed to by a **roll call vote of 17 yeas to 25 nays**.
- Ranking Member Jared Huffman (D-CA) offered an amendment to the Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Huffman #5. The amendment was not agreed to by a **roll call vote of 18 yeas to 25 nays**.
- Rep. Emily Randall (D-WA) offered an amendment to the Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Randall #6 Revised. The amendment was not agreed to by a **roll call vote of 18 yeas to 25 nays**.

H.R. 2556, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by a **roll call vote of 25 yeas to 18 nays**.

H.R. 725 (Rep. Downing), *“Crow Revenue Act”*

- Rep. Jeff Hurd (R-CO) offered an Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Hurd_018 ANS. The Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute was agreed to by **a roll call vote of 24 yeas to 17 nays, with 1 voting present.**
- Ranking Member Jared Huffman (D-CA) offered an amendment to the Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Ansari #1. The amendment was not agreed to by **a roll call vote of 16 yeas to 27 nays.**

H.R. 725, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by **a roll call vote of 27 yeas to 16 nays.**

H.R. 261 (Rep. Carter of GA), *“Undersea Cable Protection Act of 2025”*

The Subcommittee on Water, Wildlife and Fisheries was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 261.

- Chairman Bruce Westerman (R-AR) offered an Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Westerman_022 ANS. The Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute was agreed to by **voice vote.**
- Ranking Member Jared Huffman (D-CA) offered an amendment to the Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Huffman #1. The amendment was not agreed to by **a roll call vote of 18 yeas to 25 nays.**

H.R. 261, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by **a roll call vote of 25 yeas to 18 nays.**

H.R. 131 (Rep. Boebert), *“Finish the Arkansas Valley Conduit Act”*

- Rep. Lauren Boebert (R-CO) offered an Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Boebert_024 ANS. The Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute was agreed to by **unanimous consent.**

H.R. 131, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by **unanimous consent.**

H.R. 183 (Rep. McClintock), “*Law Enforcement Officer Recreation Pass Act*”

- Rep. Tom McClintock (R-CA) offered an Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated McClintock_051. The Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute was agreed to by **unanimous consent**.

H.R. 183, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by **unanimous consent**.

H.R. 410 (Rep. Begich), “*Alaska Native Vietnam Era Veterans Land Allotment Extension Act of 2025*”

The Subcommittee on Indian and Insular Affairs was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 410.

H.R. 410 was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by **unanimous consent**.

H.R. 504 (Rep. Gimenez), “*Miccosukee Reserved Area Amendments Act*”

The Subcommittee on Indian and Insular Affairs was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 504.

H.R. 504 was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by **unanimous consent**.

H.R. 655 (Rep. Bentz), “*The Dalles Watershed Development Act*”

The Subcommittee on Federal Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 655.

- Rep. Cliff Bentz (R-OR) offered an Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Bentz_023. The Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute was agreed to by **unanimous consent**.

H.R. 655, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by **unanimous consent**.

H.R. 1276 (Rep. Comer), To remove restrictions from a parcel of land in Paducah, Kentucky.

The Subcommittee on Federal Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 1276.

H.R. 1729 (Rep. Neguse), *“Bolts Ditch Act”*

H.R. 1729 was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by **unanimous consent**.

H.R. 1917 (Rep. Dingell), *“Great Lakes Mass Marking Program Act of 2025”*

The Subcommittee on Water, Wildlife and Fisheries was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 1917.

- Chairman Bruce Westerman (R-AR) offered an amendment designated Westerman #1. The amendment was agreed to by **unanimous consent**.

H.R. 1917, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by **unanimous consent**.

H.R. 2250 (Rep. DelBene), *“National Landslide Preparedness Act Reauthorization Act of 2025”*

The Subcommittee on Energy and Mineral Resources was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 2250.

- Ranking Member Jared Huffman (D-CA) offered an Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Huffman_023 ANS. The amendment was agreed to by **unanimous consent**.

H.R. 2250, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by **unanimous consent**.

H.R. 2316 (Rep. Hurd), *“Wetlands Conservation and Access Improvement Act of 2025”*

The Subcommittee on Water, Wildlife and Fisheries was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 2316.

H.R. 2316 was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by **unanimous consent**.

H.R. 2388 (Rep. Randall), “*Lower Elwha Klallam Tribe Project Lands Restoration Act*”

The Subcommittee on Indian and Insular Affairs was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 2388.

H.R. 2388 was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by **unanimous consent**.

H.R. 2389 (Rep. Randall), “*Quinault Indian Nation Land Transfer Act*”

The Subcommittee on Indian and Insular Affairs was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 2389.

H.R. 2389 was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by **unanimous consent**.

H.R. 2876 (Rep. Moore of UT), “*University of Utah Research Park Act*”

The Subcommittee on Federal Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 2876.

H.R. 2876 was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by **unanimous consent**.

H.R. 3168 (Rep. Valadao), “*National Earthquake Hazards Reduction Program Reauthorization Act of 2025*”

The Subcommittee on Energy and Mineral Resources was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 3168.

H.R. 3168 was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by **unanimous consent**.

H.R. 3176 (Rep. Begich), To amend the John D. Dingell, Jr Conservation Management, and Recreation Act to reauthorize the National volcano Early Warning and Monitoring System.

The Subcommittee on Energy and Mineral Resources was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 3176.

H.R. 3176 was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by **unanimous consent**.

[H.R. 3179 \(Rep. Babin\)](#), To rename the Anahuac National Wildlife Refuge located in the State of Texas as the "Jocelyn Nungaray National Wildlife Refuge".

The Subcommittee on Water, Wildlife and Fisheries was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 3179.

H.R. 3179 was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by **unanimous consent**.
