## COMMITTEE ON NATURAL RESOURCES -- ACTION REPORT

## H.R. 281 (Rep. Hageman), "Grizzly Bear State Management Act of 2025"

- Rep. Harriet Hageman (R-WY) offered an Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Hageman\_066 ANS. The Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute was agreed to by **voice vote.**
- Ranking Member Jared Huffman (D-CA) offered an amendment to the Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Huffman #1. The amendment was not agreed to by a roll call vote of 18 yeas to 20 nays.
- Rep. Val Hoyle (D-OR) offered an amendment to the Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Hoyle #2. The amendment was not agreed to by a roll call vote of 18 yeas to 20 nays.
- Ranking Member Jared Huffman (D-CA) offered an amendment to the Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Dingell #3. The amendment was not agreed to by a roll call vote of 18 yeas to 20 nays.

H.R. 281, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by a roll call vote of 20 yeas to 19 nays.

## H.R. 2462 (Rep. Rose), "Black Vulture Relief Act of 2025"

H.R. 2462, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by a roll call vote of 22 yeas to 18 nays.

H.R. 556 (Rep. Wittman), "Protecting Access for Hunters and Anglers Act of 2025"

- Rep. Rob Wittman (R-VA) offered an Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Wittman\_018 ANS. The Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute was agreed to by **voice vote.**
- Ranking Member Jared Huffman (D-CA) offered an amendment to the Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Dingell #1. The amendment was not agreed to by a roll call vote of 17 yeas to 23 nays.

H.R. 556, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by a roll call vote of 23 yeas to 17 nays.

H.R. 435 (Rep. Issa), "Direct Hire To Fight Fires"

H.R. 435 was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by **unanimous** consent.

H.R. 831 (Rep. Calvert), "Lower Colorado River Multi-Species Conservation Program Amendment Act of 2025"
