President and Chief Executive Officer, East Kentucky Power Cooperative

Anthony “Tony” Campbell is President and CEO of East Kentucky Power Cooperative (EKPC), a generation and transmission electric cooperative based in Winchester, Ky.

EKPC provides wholesale electric power to 16 distribution cooperatives that serve 1.1 million Kentucky residents, as well as homes, farms, businesses and industries across 89 counties. Together, EKPC and its 16 owner-member cooperatives are known as Kentucky's Touchstone Energy Cooperatives.

Before joining EKPC in June 2009, Campbell served as CEO of Citizens Electric Corporation (CEC), a transmission and distribution company located in Southeast Missouri. He also worked in Illinois as Vice President of Corn Belt Energy Corp., a distribution cooperative, and as Manager of Power Marketing for Soyland Power Cooperative, a generation and transmission cooperative.

Campbell earned his Bachelor of Science degree in Electrical Engineering from the University of Southern Illinois at Carbondale and his Masters of Business Administration from the University of Illinois at Champaign.
