<u>H.R. 839 (Rep. Arrington)</u>, To prohibit the implementation of a Land Protection Plan for Muleshoe National Wildlife Refuge.

The Subcommittee on Water, Wildlife and Fisheries was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 839.
