On behalf of the National Electrical Contractors Association's (NECA) Oregon-Columbia Chapter, Oregon Pacific-Cascade Chapter, and Northwest Line Constructors Chapter, we are writing to express our support for the Standardizing Permitting and Expediting Economic Development Act (SPEED Act). These NECA chapters represent electrical contractors in Oregon and Southwest Washington who are committed to rebuilding and modernizing our nation's electrical infrastructure for future generations through a combination of conservation, technology, and innovation.

One of our priorities over the last several years has been for the passage of comprehensive federal permitting reform and infrastructure resources authorizations, as well as expedited right-of-way permitting for transmission lines.
