On behalf of Rhode Island Manufacturers Association, I respectfully urge you to vote "yes" on the Standardizing Permitting and Expediting Economic Development Act, or SPEED Act, when it is brought before this Committee for markup. Rhode Island Manufacturers Association applauds the bipartisan efforts in this legislation to advance critical permitting reforms so manufacturers can build in America and compete across the globe.

RIMA represents over 1300 manufacturers in Rhode Island. We have been a strong voice for our members supporting legislation that supports our sector. RIMA has long called for commonsense, bipartisan permitting reforms to improve how we make and build things here in America. We need clarity and guardrails to invest and grow in America, all while maintaining public input and safeguarding our environment.

The SPEED Act provides this clarity by aligning statute with Supreme Court precedent, providing permitting certainty between administrations, codifying much-needed reforms to the judicial review process, and clarifying that NEPA is a procedural statute whose intent can be satisfied by other federal environmental permitting statutes. These reforms will make it easier and more cost-efficient for manufacturers in Rhode Island to get shovels in the ground on job-creating projects—and, as a result, this bill will strengthen manufacturing in America.
