**Amendment to the Westerman ANS to H.R. 5103**  
**Offered by Rep. Huffman**

Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the following:

**SECTION 1. Omnibus Federal payment for various initiatives.**

There is authorized to be appropriated to the District of Columbia \$1,436,000,000, to be allocated and used as follows:

- (1) \$143,600,000 of such amount shall be used for programs to expand access to health care.
- (2) \$143,600,000 of such amount shall be used for programs to reduce homelessness.
- (3) \$143,600,000 of such amount shall be used for programs to provide food assistance for the needy.
- (4) \$143,600,000 of such amount shall be used for programs to provide services for victims of crime.
- (5) \$143,600,000 of such amount shall be used for youth programs.
- (6) \$143,600,000 of such amount shall be used for community violence intervention programs.
- (7) \$143,600,000 of such amount shall be used for drug treatment programs.
- (8) \$143,600,000 of such amount shall be used for programs to provide mental health services.
- (9) \$143,600,000 of such amount shall be used for programs to prevent gun violence.
- (10) \$143,600,000 of such amount shall be used by the Office of Unified Communications for improvements to 911 service.

**SEC. 2. Other Federal payments to District of Columbia.**

(a) Metropolitan Police Department.—There is authorized to be appropriated to the District of Columbia \$100,000,000, to be used by the Chief of the Metropolitan Police Department to recruit, appoint, and train additional officers.

(b) Emergency planning and security.—There is authorized to be appropriated to the Mayor of the District of Columbia \$100,000,000, to be used to pay necessary expenses, as determined by the Mayor in written consultation with the elected county or city officials of surrounding jurisdictions, for the costs of providing public safety at events related to the presence of the National Capital in the District of Columbia, including support requested by the Director of the United States Secret Service in carrying out protective duties under the direction of the Secretary of Homeland Security, and for the costs of providing support to respond to immediate and specific terrorist threats or attacks in the District of Columbia or surrounding jurisdictions.

(c) Criminal Justice Coordinating Council.—There is authorized to be appropriated to the Criminal Justice Coordinating Council \$6,000,000, to be used to support initiatives related to the coordination of Federal and local criminal justice resources in the District of Columbia.

**SEC. 3. Other payments to support District of Columbia.**

(a) Prosecutors.—There is authorized to be appropriated to the Attorney General of the United States \$50,000,000, to be used to recruit, appoint, and train additional prosecutors and investigators for the Office of the United States Attorney for the District of Columbia.

(b) Parks and roads.—There is authorized to be appropriated \$284,000,000 for improving parks and roads in the District of Columbia, of which—

(1) 50 percent shall be available for the Director of the National Park Service; and

(2) 50 percent shall be available for the Mayor of the District of Columbia.

**SEC. 4. Continuing availability of funds.**

Amounts appropriated pursuant to the authorizations under this Act shall remain available until expended.

Amend the title so as to read: “A bill to authorize appropriations to make the District of Columbia safer and more beautiful, and for other purposes.”.
