Amendment to the Gosar ANS to H.R. 4255
Offered by Rep. Grijalva

Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the following:

SECTION 1. REPORT.

No later than 1 year after the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of the Interior shall submit to the Natural Resources Committee of the House of Representatives and the Environment and Public Works Committee of the Senate a report that includes—

(a)

(1) A county-by-county summary of the livestock loss compensation programs administered by the Secretary of the Interior, the Secretary of Agriculture, and the States relating to livestock losses from the Mexican wolf (*Canis lupus baileyi*), including the species of livestock taken, number of losses, and reimbursements;

(2) A summary of changes and updates made to livestock indemnity payments for losses due to predation from Mexican wolves as a result of the amendments enacted in Sec. 10401(a) of P.L. 119-21;

(3) An assessment of the efficacy and accessibility of such livestock loss programs, including and any plans to streamline and improve the administration of such programs; and

(b) An evaluation of the efforts of the Mexican government to recover the Mexican wolf in Mexico, including how U.S. diplomatic efforts, technical assistance, and capacity building have assisted and can help the Mexican government make progress toward the recovery of the Mexican wolf in Mexico.

Section 2. COORDINATION. In preparing the report required under Section 1, the Secretary of the Interior shall coordinate and consult with—

- (a) The Secretary of State
- (b) The Secretary of Agriculture
- (c) The governments of affected Tribes;
- (d) The Governor of Arizona; and
- (e) The Governor of New Mexico.
