

COMMITTEE ON NATURAL RESOURCES -- ACTION REPORT

The Committee on Natural Resources met in open session on Thursday, January 22, 2026, to consider the following measures. [H.R. 4255 \(Rep. Gosar\)](#), “*Enhancing Safety for Animals Act of 2025*”

The Subcommittee on Water, Wildlife and Fisheries was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 4255.

- Rep. Paul Gosar (R-AZ) offered an Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Gosar_080 ANS. The Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute **was agreed to by voice vote**.
- Rep. Adelita Grijalva (D-AZ) offered an amendment to the Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Grijalva #1. The amendment **was not agreed to by a roll call vote of 11 yeas to 19 nays**.

H.R. 4255, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by a **roll call vote of 23 yeas to 13 nays**.

[H.R. 2130 \(Rep. Johnson of SD\)](#), “*Tribal Trust Land Homeownership Act of 2025*”

The Subcommittee on Indian and Insular Affairs was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 2130.

H.R. 2130 was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by **unanimous consent**.

[H.R. 3073 \(Rep. Maloy\)](#), “*Shivwits Band of Paiutes Jurisdictional Clarity Act*”

The Subcommittee on Indian and Insular Affairs was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 3073.

H.R. 3073 was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by **unanimous consent**.

[H.R. 3340 \(Rep. Fry\)](#), “*Modernizing Access to Our Public Oceans Act*”

[H.R. 4294 \(Rep. Elfreth\)](#), “*Mitigation Action and Watermen Support Act of 2025*” or the “*MAWS Act of 2025*”

The Subcommittee on Water, Wildlife and Fisheries was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 4294.

- Rep. Sarah Elfreth (D-MD) offered an Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Elfreth_058 ANS. The Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute **was agreed to by unanimous consent**.

H.R. 4294, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by **unanimous consent**.

[H.R. 5254 \(Rep. Bell\)](#), “*Gateway Partnership Act of 2025*”

The Subcommittee on Federal Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 5254.

- Rep. Joe Neguse (D-CO) offered an Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Neguse #1 ANS revised. The Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute **was agreed to by unanimous consent**.

H.R. 5254, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by **unanimous consent**.

The Subcommittee on Federal Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 5729.

- Chairman Bruce Westerman (R-AR) offered an Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Westerman_049 ANS. The Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute **was agreed to by unanimous consent**.

H.R. 5729, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by **unanimous consent**.

The Subcommittee on Federal Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 6365.
