[H.R. 3276 \(Rep. Dingell\)](#), *“Local Communities & Bird Habitat Stewardship Act of 2025”*

The Subcommittee on Water, Wildlife and Fisheries was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 3276.

- Rep. Debbie Dingell (D-MI) offered an Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Dingell_159 ANS. The Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute **was agreed to by unanimous consent**.

H.R. 3276, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by **unanimous consent**.

[H.R. 3925 \(Rep. Obernolte\)](#), *“Yuhaaviatam of San Manuel Nation Land Exchange Act”*

The Subcommittee on Indian and Insular Affairs was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 3925.

- Rep. Jeff Hurd (R-CO) offered an Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Hurd_ANS. The Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute **was agreed to by unanimous consent**.

H.R. 3925, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by **unanimous consent**.

[H.R. 7882 \(Rep. Stauber\)](#), To provide for the leasing of certain deposits of minerals located within the City of Carlsbad, New Mexico.

The Subcommittee on Energy and Mineral Resources was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 7882.

- Rep. Pete Stauber (R-MN) offered an Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute designated Stauber_051 ANS. The Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute **was agreed to by unanimous consent.**

H.R. 7882, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by **unanimous consent.**

[H.R. 8686 \(Rep. Gosar\)](#), To amend the Military Land Withdrawals Act of 2013 to withdraw and reserve certain public land in the vicinity of Yuma Proving Ground, Arizona.

The Subcommittee on Federal Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 8686.

- Rep. Paul Gosar (R-AZ) offered an amendment designated Gosar_105. The amendment **was agreed to by unanimous consent.**

H.R. 8686, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by **unanimous consent.**
