

AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE
TO H.R. 8454
OFFERED BY MR. MCCLINTOCK OF CALIFORNIA

Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the following:

1 SECTION 1. TRANSFER OF ADMINISTRATIVE JURISDICTION
2 OVER CERTAIN FEDERAL LAND IN THE
3 STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

4 (a) TRANSFER OF ADMINISTRATIVE JURISDIC-
5 TION.—

6 (1) NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM LAND.—Admin-
7 istrative jurisdiction over the approximately 160
8 acres of National Forest System land more particu-
9 larly described as T.1 S., R.19 E., sec. 24,
10 SE¹/₄NE¹/₄, NW¹/₄SE¹/₄, NE¹/₄SE¹/₄, and
11 SE¹/₄SE¹/₄, Mount Diablo Meridian, Tuolumne
12 County, California, as generally depicted on the map
13 entitled “Ackerson Meadow Land Interchange” and
14 dated February 24, 2022, is transferred to the Sec-
15 retary of the Interior to be managed as part of Yo-
16 semite National Park, in accordance with laws appli-
17 cable to the National Park System.

1 (2) NATIONAL PARK SYSTEM LAND.—Adminis-
2 trative jurisdiction over the approximately 170 acres
3 of National Park System land more particularly de-
4 scribed as the SE¹/₄ of sec. 23 and the land to the
5 north and west of Road 1S25 within the
6 NW¹/₄SE¹/₄NW¹/₄ of sec. 24, T.1 S., R. 19 E.,
7 Mount Diablo Meridian, Tuolumne County, Cali-
8 fornia, as generally depicted on the map entitled
9 “Ackerson Meadow Land Interchange” and dated
10 February 24, 2022, is transferred to the Secretary
11 of Agriculture to be managed as part of Stanislaus
12 National Forest in accordance with laws applicable
13 to the National Forest System.

14 (b) CORRECTIONS.—

15 (1) MINOR ADJUSTMENTS.—The Secretary of
16 Agriculture and the Secretary of the Interior may,
17 by mutual agreement, make minor corrections and
18 adjustments to the Federal land transferred under
19 subsection (a) to facilitate land management, includ-
20 ing making a correction or adjustment to any appli-
21 cable survey.

22 (2) PUBLICATIONS.—Any correction or adjust-
23 ment made under paragraph (1) shall be effective on
24 the date of publication of a notice of the correction
25 or adjustment in the Federal Register.

1 (c) EFFECT ON EXISTING RIGHTS AND AUTHORIZA-
2 TIONS.—Nothing in this section affects—

3 (1) any valid existing rights; or

4 (2) the validity or terms and conditions of any
5 existing withdrawal, right-of-way, easement, lease, li-
6 cense, or permit on the land to which administrative
7 jurisdiction is transferred under this section, except
8 that beginning on the date of enactment of this Act,
9 the head of the agency to which administrative juris-
10 diction over the land is transferred shall be respon-
11 sible for administering the interests or authoriza-
12 tions in accordance with applicable law.
