Louisiana State Senator Sharon Hewitt is an engineer and a former oil and gas executive, responsible for major assets in the Deepwater Gulf of Mexico. In 2015, Hewitt was elected to her first political office and now serves on the powerful Senate Finance Committee, is Vice-Chairman of the Senate Transportation Committee, and serves as Vice-Chairman of the Louisiana Legislative Women's Caucus.
