

**David J. Hayes** is Executive Director of the State Energy & Environmental Impact Center at NYU School of Law. The Center supports state attorneys general in defending and promoting clean energy, climate and environmental laws and policies.

Hayes served as the Deputy Secretary and Chief Operating Officer at the Department of the Interior for Presidents Bill Clinton and Barack Obama (1999-2001; 2009-2013) and as Counselor to former Secretary of the Interior Bruce Babbitt (1997-1999). He is an Adjunct Professor at NYU School of Law and is on the board of the Coalition for Green Capital and Stanford University's Bill Lane Center for the American West. He is a former Distinguished Visiting Lecturer at the Stanford Law School (2013-2017), a former Senior Fellow at the Hewlett Foundation, and a former Fellow at Stanford's Woods Institute for the Environment and Precourt Institute for Energy.

Earlier in his career, Hayes was global chair of the Environment, Land & Resources department at Latham & Watkins, an international law firm. He is a graduate of the University of Notre Dame and Stanford Law School.
