

Lori Wrotenbery is Executive Director of the Interstate Oil and Gas Compact Commission, a government organization of oil and gas producing states that champions the conservation and efficient recovery of domestic oil and gas resources while protecting health, safety, and the environment. At IOGCC she serves the governors and oil and gas regulators of 31 member states and seven associate member states. She also currently serves as a member of the National Petroleum Council, an oil and natural gas advisory committee to the Secretary of Energy.

Ms. Wrotenbery's previous service to the states included leadership roles at the oil and gas regulatory agencies in Texas, New Mexico, and Oklahoma. Among the highlights of her career, she held the position of oil and gas director in each of those three states.

She earned a B.A. in Anthropology from Wellesley College, a B.S. in Geology from the University of Texas, and a J.D. from Harvard University.
