Scott is an experienced executive with a uniquely broad governmental perspective, having worked as both a career civil servant and political appointee in the federal government, as staff to the Governor of California, as a Congressional staffer to US Senator Chic Hecht (R-NV), and as an elected official in Fairfax County, Virginia. In addition, he has worked with corporations, a trade association, government contractors, and in the nonprofit sector.

Scott recently served as Acting Assistant Secretary for Policy, Management and Budget at the U.S. Department of the Interior. In that capacity he oversaw Department-wide budget, finance, acquisition, financial assistance, information technology, human resource management, wildland fire, and invasive species programs, among other programs, for this \$14 billion agency with 65,000 employees.

Scott is a Fellow of the National Academy of Public Administration, a member of the Board of Directors of the Senior Executives Association, a SAGE with the Partnership for Public Service, and an Associate Director of the Northern Virginia Soil and Water Conservation District, where he chairs its Legislative Committee.
