On **Tuesday, July 19, 2022, at 10:00 a.m. ET, in 1324 Longworth HOB and via Cisco Webex**, the Subcommittee on Energy and Mineral Resources will hold a hybrid legislative hearing on the following bills:

- [H.R. 3681](#) (Rep. Darren Soto, D-FL) To direct the United States Geological Survey to establish a program to map zones that area at greater risk of sinkhole formation, and for other purposes. *Sinkhole Mapping Act of 2021*.
- [H.R. 5522](#) (Rep. Ron Kind, D-WI) To require the Secretary of the Interior to develop and maintain a cadastre of Federal real property. *Federal Land Asset Inventory Reform Act*.
- [H.R. 5805](#) (Rep. Melanie Stansbury, D-NM) To withdraw certain Bureau of Land Management Land from mineral development. *Buffalo Tract Protection Act*.
- [H.R. 5350](#) (Rep. Russ Fulcher, R-ID) To amend the Geothermal Steam Act of 1970 to promote timely exploration for geothermal resources under geothermal leases, and for other purposes. *Enhancing Geothermal Production on Federal Lands Act*.
