Morgan D. Bazilian is the Director of the Payne Institute for Public Policy and Professor at the Colorado School of Mines. Previously, he was Lead Energy Specialist at the World Bank. Earlier in his career, Bazilian was a senior diplomat at the United Nations focusing on energy poverty. He is one of the world's foremost experts on energy and minerals security, policy, markets, and investment. Dr. Bazilian holds a Ph.D in thermodynamics, and was a Fulbright fellow. He has published more than 200 scholarly articles, and has been published in *Science*, *Nature*, *Foreign Affairs*, *Foreign Policy*, and *Proceedings of the National Academy of Science*. He is a Member of the Council on Foreign Relations, a Global Fellow at the Wilson Center and the Center for Strategic and International Studies, an Energy Security advisor to the National Renewable Energy Laboratory, and an adjunct professor of thermal physics at University College Cork.
