Subject: Legislative Hearing – July 29, 2014

On **Tuesday, July 29, 2014 at 10:00 a.m. in room 1324 Longworth House Office Building**, the Subcommittee on Public Lands and Environmental Regulation will hold a legislative hearing on the following bills:

- **H.R. 445** (Dent), To authorize a National Heritage Area Program, and for other purposes. *“National Heritage Area Act of 2013”*
- **H.R. 1785** (Reichert), To establish the Mountains to Sound Greenway National Heritage Area in the State of Washington, and for other purposes. *“Mountains to Sound Greenway National Heritage Area Act”*
- **H.R. 4119** (Johnson of GA), To direct the Secretary of the Interior to conduct a special resource study of the West Hunter Street Baptist Church in Atlanta, Georgia, and for other purposes. *“West Hunter Street Baptist Church Study Act”*
- **H.R. 4901** (Bishop), To maximize land management efficiencies, promote land conservation, generate education funding, and for other purposes. *“Advancing Conservation and Education Act of 2014”*
- **H.R. 4979** (Thornberry), To provide legal certainty to property owners along the Red River in Texas, and for other purposes. *“Red River Private Property Protection Act”*
- **H.R. 5086** (Fortenberry), To amend the National Trails System Act to direct the Secretary of the Interior to conduct a study on the feasibility of designating the Chief Standing Bear National Historic Trail, and for other purposes.
- **S. 311** (Landrieu), A bill to direct the Secretary of the Interior to study the suitability and feasibility of designating sites in the Lower Mississippi River Area in the State of Louisiana as a unit of the National Park System, and for other purposes. *“Lower Mississippi River Area Study Act”*
- **S. 476** (Cardin), A bill to amend the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal Development Act to extend to the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal National Historical Park Commission.
