A BILL

To amend the District of Columbia Stadium Act of 1957 to extend for an additional 50 years the lease under which the government of the District of Columbia uses the ground under and the parking facilities associated with Robert F. Kennedy Memorial Stadium.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF LEASE FOR USE OF GROUND**
2 **AND PARKING FACILITIES OF ROBERT F.**
3 **KENNEDY STADIUM BY GOVERNMENT OF THE**
4 **DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA.**

5 Section 7(b) of the District of Columbia Stadium Act
6 of 1957 (sec. 3–326(b), D.C. Official Code) is amended—

7 (1) in paragraph (2), by striking “The lease”
8 and inserting “Except as provided in paragraph (3),
9 the lease”; and

10 (2) by adding at the end the following new
11 paragraph:

12 “(3) The Secretary of the Interior shall extend the
13 lease authorized by paragraph (1)(B) so that the lease
14 shall be in effect for a total period of 100 years.”.

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
