He has worked in and managed government and public affairs operations at the local, state and federal levels, representing a variety of interests including heavy civil construction, public infrastructure finance, utility and aggregate industries.

- Prior to working for CALCIMA, Dugan served as Vice President for Advocacy and Public Affairs for the Associated General Contractors of America (AGC).
- Previously, Dugan served as senior vice president of public policy and economic development for the Sacramento Metro Chamber, Director of Government and Public Affairs for Granite Construction and as director of governmental and civic affairs for California State University - Sacramento.
- Dugan began his career in government and public affairs serving as district director for California State Sen. Tim Leslie focused on natural resources, infrastructure and local government governance issues.
- Dugan currently serves on the board of the Sacramento State Alumni Association, Placer County, and is President of the Sierra College Foundation.
- Dugan is a graduate of California State University Sacramento, where he earned a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration, with a concentration in marketing and a minor in communications.
