- **H.R. 4716 (Rep. Owens)**, To transfer administrative jurisdiction of certain Federal land in Saratoga Springs, Utah, from the Secretary of the Interior to the United States Postal Service for construction of a post office, and for other purposes.
- **H.R. 5555 (Rep. Panetta)**, *“Monterey Bay National Heritage Area Study Act”*
