Commissioner Bobbie Daniel is a sixth-generation Colorado native serving her first term on the Mesa County Board of County Commissioners. She represents one of the largest natural-resource-producing regions on Colorado's Western Slope and advocates for policies that support rural communities, agriculture, energy production, and responsible stewardship of public lands and natural resources.

Commissioner Daniel also serves as Vice- Chair on the National Association of Counties Public Lands Steering Committee, where she works on issues involving federal land management, local government coordination, water policy, natural resource development, disaster recovery, forest mitigation, watershed health and responsible forest management. She has been deeply involved in regional and statewide efforts surrounding Colorado River water policy, including preservation of the historic Shoshone water rights, protection of agricultural communities, and long-term Western water sustainability.

She and her husband, Nick, are raising their four children in Grand Junction, Colorado.
