

**Biography of

Terry A. Sayre has deep roots in Tulare having lived here for over fifty years. She and her late husband, Richard Sayre, raised their five children here in Tulare. She taught school for Tulare City Schools for over 30 years. She received her BA in Education from Arizona State University and her Master's Degree from Fresno Pacific University. Ms. Sayre retired from teaching in 2006 and began a career as a consultant, leadership facilitator, and life coach. She continues to support student teachers and interns as a University supervisor.

Ms. Sayre has been involved with the community in many capacities. She supported her children as a Tulare Union High School band booster, a Sharks swim club officer, and a co-director of Encore Kids and the Encore Board of Directors. Recently, she was the facilitator of Leadership Tulare, a program through the Tulare Chamber of Commerce and is currently an Ambassador for the Chamber. She has served on the Library Advisory Board and currently serves on the Board of Salt + Light, a non-profit establishing community for our neighbors experiencing homelessness. She is currently the president of the Noon Kiwanis Club and has been a member since her retirement. She has served as president of DKG, an organization that serves women educators and promotes the education of women throughout the world.

Since being elected to the Tulare City Council in 2018, she has served on the Tulare Association of County Governments, the Economic Development Corporation, the Tulare County Task Force on Homelessness, and the Council of Cities as the Tulare representative or alternate. She has traveled to Washington D.C. as a delegate to promote Tulare County projects and the interests of Tulare. She is active in her church and serves on a variety of committees.
