SUBJECT: Hybrid WOW Legislative Hearing – June 16, 2022

On Thursday, June 16, 2022 at 9:00 a.m. ET, in room 1324 Longworth House Office Building and via Cisco WebEx, the Subcommittee on Water, Oceans, and Wildlife will hold a hybrid legislative hearing on the following bills:

- <u>H.R. 4768</u> (Rep. David Joyce, R-OH) To require the Secretary of the Army to initiate at least 5 projects to reduce the loss and degradation of Great Lakes coastal wetlands, and for other purposes. *Detrimental Erosion Forcing Enhanced Needs to Defend (DEFEND) the Great Lakes Act*.
- <u>H.R. 6936</u> (Rep. Elise Stefanik, R-NY) To provide for the issuance of a semipostal to benefit programs that combat invasive species. *Stamp Out Invasive Species Act*.
- <u>H.R. 6949</u> (Rep. Dwight Evans, D-PA) To amend the Water Infrastructure Improvements for the Nation Act to reauthorize Delaware River Basin conservation programs, and for other purposes. *Delaware River Basin Conservation Reauthorization Act of 2022*.
- <u>H.R. 7398</u> (Rep. Steve Cohen, D-TN) To prohibit wildlife killing contests on public lands, and for other purposes. *Prohibit Wildlife Killing Contests Act of 2022*.
- <u>H.R. 7792</u> (Rep. Melanie Stansbury, D-NM) To provide for a national water data framework, and for other purposes. *Water Data Act*.
- <u>H.R. 7793</u> (Rep. Melanie Stansbury, D-NM) To provide for the water security of the Rio Grande Basin, to reauthorize irrigation infrastructure grants, and for other purposes. *Rio Grande Water Security Act*.
- <u>H.R. 7801</u> (Rep. Mike Levin, D-CA) To amend the Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972 to allow the Secretary of Commerce to establish a Coastal and Estuarine Resilience and Restoration Program, and for other purposes.
