A BILL

To require the Secretary of the Interior to reissue regulations removing the gray wolf from the list of endangered and threatened wildlife under the Endangered Species Act of 1973.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Trust the Science
5 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REMOVING THE GRAY WOLF FROM THE LIST OF EN-**
2 **DANGERED AND THREATENED WILDLIFE.**

3 Not later than 60 days after the date of enactment
4 of this section, the Secretary of the Interior shall reissue
5 the final rule entitled “Endangered and Threatened Wild-
6 life and Plants; Removing the Gray Wolf (*Canis lupus*)
7 From the List of Endangered and Threatened Wildlife”
8 and published on November 3, 2020 (85 Fed. Reg.
9 69778).

10 **SEC. 3. NO JUDICIAL REVIEW.**

11 Reissuance of the final rule under section 2 shall not
12 be subject to judicial review.
