Alex McGregor is Chairman of The McGregor Company, a farm supply business and also serves as Managing General Partner of McGregor Land & Livestock, a 140-year-old eastern Washington family wheat, alfalfa, barley and livestock ranch.

Alex earned his bachelor's degree from Whitman College; his masters & PhD from the University of Washington and taught at both schools before rejoining his family business. His book, Counting Sheep, a history of agriculture in the Inland Northwest, was chosen as one of the top one hundred "Centennial Books" written since Washington became a state. His most recent book, co-authored with Richard Scheuerman, Harvest Heritage, was published by the Washington State University Press.

Alex served as an officer and president of the Washington Association of Wheat Growers and is a long-time director for the Association of Washington Business where he headed the Rural Vitality Committee. He also serves as chair for the ALL Foundation for the Washington Secretary of State and for the Whitman College Farm Committee. Honors include the Visionary Award from the Mid-Columbia Agriculture Hall of Fame, the Jack Eberspacher Lifetime Achievement Award from the Agricultural Retailers Association, and Member of the Year honors from the Washington Association of Wheat Growers.
