Jesse Murray serves as the Senior Vice President of Energy Delivery NV Energy. He is responsible for all electric and natural gas transmission and distribution operations, engineering and design, project management, inspection, warehousing, and emergency response operations for Nevada. He is also responsible for overseeing the PowerSafe NV program, working to ensure that Nevada's communities are protected from the threats of wildfire and other natural disasters. He has led PowerSafe NV for NV Energy since 2021.

NV Energy delivers electricity to nearly 1.4 million customers and over 50 million tourists annually throughout its nearly 45,703-mile service territory in the state of Nevada. The company also provides natural gas to 200,000 customers in the Reno-Sparks, Nevada area.

Prior to this current role, Jesse worked in other executive and management roles, including overseeing NV Energy's natural gas distribution utility and leading the customer focused renewable energy programs. He started his career with NV Energy as an intern and then worked in engineering roles at natural gas fired combined cycle power plants, planning and executing on major maintenance outages and completing plant betterment projects. Jesse also spent a few years working outside of the utility industry, serving as a facilities project manager for International Game Technology and working at the Idaho National Laboratory on environmental remediation of nuclear and chemically hazardous waste. He is a registered professional chemical engineer in the state of Nevada.

Jesse is a first-generation college graduate in his family and obtained both his Bachelor's Degree in Chemical Engineering and his MBA from the University of Nevada, Reno. He was born and raised in Las Vegas and has lived in northern Nevada for 25 years. He currently lives in southwest Reno with his wife Pam and two sons Vince and Matthew who attend Reno High School. He is very active in the community, previously serving as past chair and member of the Truckee Meadows Community College Foundation Board and the United Way of Northern Nevada and the Sierra Board of Directors. He currently serves as a Trustee on the Desert Research Institute Foundation, a member of the University of Nevada, a member of Reno Alumni Council, a member of the University of Nevada College of Engineering Advisory Board and a member of the Smartest Forest Fund Committee for the Tahoe Fund.
