**A BILL**

To amend the Magnuson-Stevens Fishery Conservation and Management Act to provide for the regulation of fishing in marine national monuments.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REGULATION OF FISHING IN MARINE NA-**  
4 **TIONAL MONUMENTS.**

5 Section 304 of the Magnuson-Stevens Fishery Con-  
6 servation and Management Act (16 U.S.C. 1854) is  
7 amended by adding at the end the following:

1       “(j) REGULATION OF FISHING IN MARINE NATIONAL  
2 MONUMENTS.—

3               “(1) PROHIBITION ON REGULATION BY PRESI-  
4 DENTIAL PROCLAMATION.—Fishing in a marine na-  
5 tional monument shall not be prohibited or otherwise  
6 regulated through a Presidential proclamation under  
7 section 320301 of title 54, United States Code (com-  
8 monly known as the ‘Antiquities Act of 1906’), in-  
9 cluding any existing such Presidential proclamation.

10              “(2) CONTINUED REGULATION UNDER THIS  
11 ACT.—Fishing in a marine national monument shall  
12 continue to be regulated pursuant to this Act, con-  
13 sistent with other applicable law.”.
