Before his time on the council, Hillaire served for five years as Chief of Staff to the Lummi Nation, bringing leadership and operational experience to the Nation's highest levels of governance.

Throughout his tenure in tribal leadership, Chairman Hillaire has prioritized addressing the devastating impacts of the drug epidemic on Indigenous communities. He has been a strong and consistent voice—locally, regionally, and nationally—advocating for resources, awareness, and action to combat the crisis. His leadership centers on protecting the health, safety, and sovereignty of the Lummi people, ensuring that community voices guide solutions and that the Nation's cultural values remain at the forefront of every decision.
