Subject: Legislative Hearing – July 29, 2014

On Tuesday, July 29, 2014, at 2:00 p.m., in Room 1324 Longworth House Office Building, the Committee on Natural Resources, Subcommittee on Indian and Alaska Native Affairs will hold a legislative hearing on:

- **H.R. 3608 (Nolan)**, To amend the Act of October 19, 1973, concerning taxable income to members of the Grand Portage Band of Lake Superior Chippewa Indians. *“Grand Portage Band Per Capita Adjustment Act”*,
- **H.R. 4534 (Cramer)**, To amend the Indian Child Protection and Family Violence Prevention Act to require background checks before foster care placements are ordered in tribal court proceedings, and for other purposes. *“Native American Children’s Safety Act”*,
- **H.R. 5020 (Daines)**, To amend the Indian Land Consolidation Act to authorize the Secretary of the Interior to contract with eligible Indian tribes to manage land buy-back programs, to authorize that certain amounts be deposited into interest bearing accounts, and for other purposes. *“Indian Tribal Self-Determination in Land Consolidation Act of 2014”*,
- **H.R. 5049 (Simpson)**, To exchange trust and fee land to resolve land disputes created by the realignment of the Blackfoot River along the boundary of the Fort Hall Indian Reservation, and for other purposes. *“Blackfoot River Land Exchange Act of 2014”*; and
- **H.R. 5050 (Simpson)**, To repeal the Act of May 31, 1918, and for other purposes. *“May 31, 1918 Act Repeal Act”*
