A BILL

To amend the Indian Health Care Improvement Act to authorize urban Indian organizations to enter into arrangements for the sharing of medical services and facilities, and for other purposes.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Health Care Access
5 for Urban Native Veterans Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. SHARING ARRANGEMENTS WITH FEDERAL AGEN-**
2 **CIES.**

3 Section 405 of the Indian Health Care Improvement
4 Act (25 U.S.C. 1645) is amended—

5 (1) in subsection (a)(1), by inserting “urban In-
6 dian organizations,” before “and tribal organiza-
7 tions”; and

8 (2) in subsection (c)—

9 (A) by inserting “urban Indian organiza-
10 tion,” before “or tribal organization”; and

11 (B) by inserting “an urban Indian organi-
12 zation,” before “or a tribal organization”.

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
