**Questions from Rep. Raúl M. Grijalva** for Mr. Adrian Stevens, Acting Chairman, Board of Directors & National American Indian Housing Council:

- 1. Despite the passage of recent housing funding increases, your testimony mentions that the housing shortages across Indian Country cannot be fixed overnight.
  - a. In your opinion, how can Congress better address the systemic housing disparities that affect tribal communities?
- 2. Your testimony mentions the construction difficulties that tribal governments have faced throughout this pandemic, even with additional housing funding. Can you please elaborate on this issue?
  - a. Does the National American Indian Housing Council (NAIHC) have a policy recommendation for this specific problem?
- 3. Your testimony also highlights the concerns raised by tribal leaders about the Treasury Department's funding formulas' rigidity—precisely, with the Emergency Rental Assistance Program. Can you please elaborate on this issue?
  - a. Have tribal governments experienced similar funding barriers in other pandemic relief programs?
  - b. Moving forward, what can Congress do to support tribal governments on this issue?
- 4. Based on your organization's feedback from tribal governments, what role has tribal consultation played in the federal government's disbursement of all COVID-19 related housing funds?
  - a. What, if anything, can be improved about such consultations?
